



Social Media Code of Conduct

1. We expect our players to act in a responsible and professional manner when using any form of social media including messaging services such as WhatsApp, Snap Chat, Telegram etc.
2. Players are reminded that any social media post related to the club or related to any other Player should be respectful, avoiding bullying, harassment, and negative comments.
3. Players must report any negative comments or activities they witness on their own social accounts to the management of the Club.
4. Players are reminded that any actions on social media which could adversely affect the reputation of the Club will be subject to disciplinary action.
5. Consequences for non-compliance with this policy will include disciplinary action by the Executive Committee of Guildford Owls, and will include:
 - Suspension from the Team from training and competition
 - Disqualification from any Club awards
 - Referral to the NSW JRL Judiciary where further sanctions may be applied including:
 - Suspension of the Team from the competition and removal of competition points
 - Suspension of the Player from the competition
 - Fines against the Club
 - Disqualification of the Team or Player from being eligible for any Rep team
